

Owyhee Fly Fisher Checklist

Below is a list of things that will help you for your day on the water!

YOUR TRIP INCLUDES:

- Gourmet lunch (full day trips only)
- · Use of Rods, Reels, Line, Tippet, Flies
- Waders & boots upon request (free of charge)

THINGS FOR YOU TO DO:

- Fill out the waiver that was emailed to you each person coming with you will need to do this. If you are a returning client, we already have yours on file
- Get your Oregon Fishing License. You can get it at the link below or at the Owyhee Junction Store. Getting it online
 gets you on the water faster. https://myodfw.com
- Let your guide know if you have any food restrictions or equipment needs (they will need shoe size and height for waders) Guides will call/text you as it gets closer for this information.

OTHER THINGS THAT MAY HELP YOU:

- 5 or 6 weight rod and matching weight forward floating line
- Long pants under waders is way more comfortable than shorts. Water temperatures are always around 50 degrees.
- Check weather forecast a couple days before your trip if showers are expected a rain jacket of some sort is helpful.
- Polarized sunglasses are a must!
- · Fingerless gloves for cooler months and sun gloves for summer months
- · Lip Balm and sunscreen June to October
- A couple of 9 ft, 4x and 5x leaders

PAYMENT/BALANCE OWING:

This can be paid before your day on the river by clicking on the "pay invoice" tab on your e invoice that will be emailed to you a before your trip. You can also pay your guide at the end of the day with cash, check or credit card (4% processing fee for credit card transactions).
